

Academic Scholarship

The academic scholarships are intended for undergraduate students who have not previously obtained a Bachelor's degree (or equivalent).

The purpose of this type of scholarship is to reward the academic success of those students who obtain good grades.

The maximum amount of the scholarship is 24,000 Euros, for 4 years (6,000 Euros for each academic year) and is applicable to a maximum of 12 academic periods (Fall, Spring and Summer).

The total amount of the scholarship will be discounted in the three academic periods:

- 40% Fall Semester.
- 40% Spring Semester.
- 20% Summer Course.

The student who benefits from this type of scholarship must show special support and collaboration with the University and may be proposed to perform volunteer work, collaborating, when required, in acts and events organized by the International Studies Foundation and the NGO Cruzada por los Niños, managed by CIS.

Requirements

- Be an admitted student (new student) or enrolled student in CIS.
 - Admitted students (new students) will have a period of 10 days to confirm the enrollment, starting from the date when the grant of the scholarship has been communicated.
 - Students who apply for this scholarship, and who have already started their studies at CIS, will not be eligible for this scholarship if they have pending payments.
- Minimum average grade (G.P.A.): 3.0 (or equivalent).
- Presentation of the following documentation:
 - Scholarship application form.
 - Essay explaining the causes that motivate the scholarship application.
 - Economic information of the person(s) responsible for the student's payments. This information is not obligatory, but it will be considered in case there is a large number of applications.
- Be a full-time student: Take all the credits during the three academic periods:
 - Fall and Spring Semesters: 12-15 credits.
 - Summer Course: 6 credits.

Scholarship application resolution

The Scholarship Committee will respond to the request within a maximum period of 15 days, indicating the amount of the scholarship.

If the resolution is positive but the requested scholarship cannot be granted immediately, due to lack of funds, the scholarship will be suspended, and will be applied as soon as funds are available.

At the end of each Academic Semester (Fall, Spring and Summer), the Scholarships Committee will check that all students who are beneficiaries of the scholarship continue to meet the necessary requirements for the maintenance of the same (GPA, full time student and non-existence of pending payments), in order to renew the scholarship for the following period.
