

# Presidential Scholarship

The presidential scholarship is an extraordinary scholarship intended to recognize academic excellence coupled with personal or social merits.

**FOR:**  
**UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS**

**MAXIMUM SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:**  
**9,100€ PER ACADEMIC YEAR**

The total amount of the scholarship will be discounted proportionally from each academic semester

Students benefitting from this type of scholarship must show special support and collaboration with the university and may be expected to perform volunteer work, collaborating, when required, in acts and events organized by the International Studies Foundation, the NGO Cruzada por los Niños, and RFK Spain Foundation (CIS Corporate Social Responsibility).

## GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- > Be admitted as a student (new student) or enrolled as a student at CIS.
  - > Admitted students (new students) who are chosen for the scholarship will have 10 days to confirm their enrollment starting from the date they are notified.
  - > Students who apply for this scholarship, and who have already started their studies at CIS University, must have met all the financial requirements of the academic course.
- > Minimum average grade (GPA) 3.8 (or equivalent).
- > Submission of the following documentation:
  - > Scholarship application form.
  - > Essay explaining the reasons for applying to the scholarship.
  - > Personal merits will be valued in these areas: social, human rights, entrepreneurship and innovation.
- > Be a full-time student (Fall-Spring).



## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RESOLUTION

The Scholarship Committee will respond to the request within a maximum period of 15 days, indicating the amount of the scholarship.

If the resolution is positive but the requested scholarship cannot be granted immediately, due to lack of funds, the scholarship will be suspended, and will be applied as soon as funds are available.

At the end of each Academic Semester (Fall, Spring and Summer), the Scholarships Committee will check that all students who are beneficiaries continue to meet the necessary requirements, in order to renew the scholarship for the following period.
