

Work Scholarship

Work Scholarships are available to undergraduate students who wish to contribute to university activities. Availability depends on the University's staffing needs. Scholarship recipients will be informed of their assigned responsibilities and required working hours.

**MAXIMUM
SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT:**

€2,400 PER ACADEMIC YEAR

The total scholarship amount will be proportionally deducted from each academic semester based on the number of credits



GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Be admitted as a student (for new students) or be a current CIS University student.
 - >Admitted students (new students) who are chosen for the scholarship will have 10 days to confirm their enrollment starting from the date they are notified.
 - >Students who apply for this scholarship, and who have already started their studies at CIS University, must have met all the financial requirements of the academic course.
2. Minimum average grade (GPA) 2.4 (or equivalent).
3. Submission of the following documentation:
 - >Scholarship application form.
 - >Essay explaining the reasons for applying to the scholarship.
4. Be a full-time student (Fall and Spring).
5. Not to be the beneficiary of any other type of aid destined for the same purpose.
6. Have no record of disciplinary sanctions during their academic career.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RESOLUTION

The Scholarship Committee will respond to the request of admitted students (new students) within a maximum period of 15 days, indicating the amount of the scholarship that has been granted.

Applications from current students—including new scholarship requests and requests for an increase to an existing scholarship—are reviewed at the end of each academic semester (Fall and Spring) and at the end of the academic year (during the month of July).

If the resolution is positive but the requested scholarship cannot be granted immediately, due to lack of funds, the scholarship will be suspended, and will be applied as soon as funds are available.

Scholarships are automatically renewed as long as students continue to meet the eligibility requirements under which they were originally awarded.
